I'm sure they will enjoy our great facilities and golf course and establish some life long friendships.

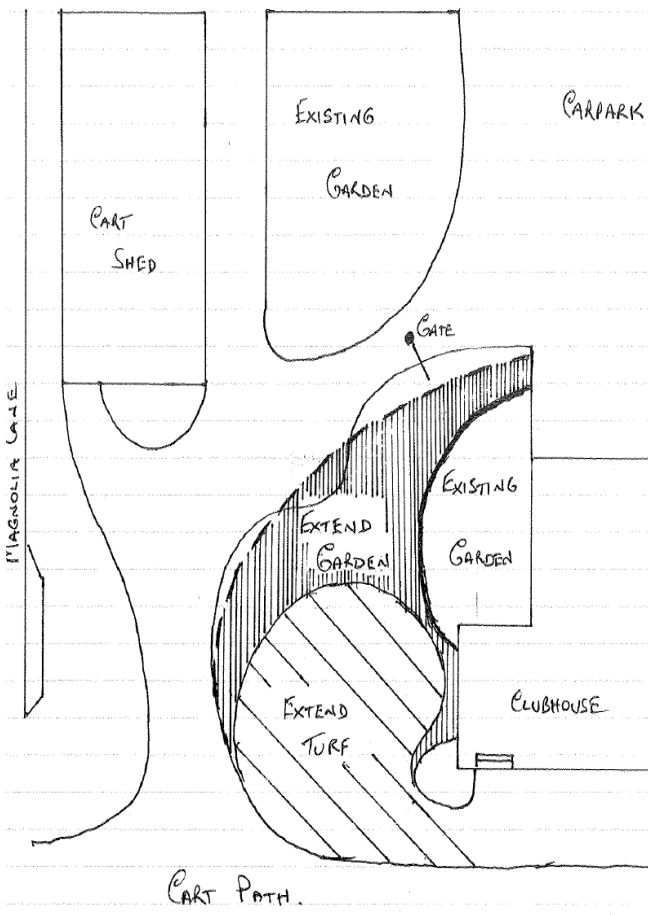
